

Getting to the Isle of Mull

Bac Mór

The Isle of Mull is easy to get to, with three car ferries to the mainland. The most popular and largest sails from Oban to Craignure. This ferry takes 45 minutes and **Bac Mór** is about 35 minutes drive from Craignure. Booking is essential for this crossing: phone 0875650000 or visit www.calmac.co.uk.

Mull offers wonderful beaches (Calgary, voted one of the top beaches in the world is 8½ miles away), outstanding wildlife, incredible sea and landscapes, a rich cultural life and the opportunity to experience as much peace and solitude as you wish.

However, there are also very good bars, restaurants and a variety of visitor attractions, from wildlife-watching tours to concerts, theatre and castles.

The ferry to Iona runs from Mull, and trips to the Treshnish Isles and Staffa (booking required: 01688400242) start from Ulva Ferry, just a few miles away!

stunning views. This means that you can enjoy the panorama of Loch Tuath and the Treshnish Isles from the sofa.

The **Bac Mór** kitchen area is compact, but very well equipped with an electric hob and oven, fridge, microwave and toaster. All crockery, cutlery, cooking utensils and ecological cleaning materials are provided.

The bedroom has a very comfortable double bed, chests of drawers and a wardrobe. Duvet, bedlinen and towels are

all provided. The bathroom has a full-sized bath (with shower above), sink, WC and a large heated towel rail.

Bac Mór is centrally heated, double-glazed and well insulated, so is ideal for holidays at any time of the year. All electricity and heating costs are included in the weekly rental.

Bac Mór is situated on the north-west coast of Mull, 15 minutes drive from Dervaig, 25 minutes from Salen and 30 minutes from Tobermory, the island's main town.

There are excellent walks from **Bac Mór** to enjoy the peace, wildlife and incomparable landscape of this unique area.
